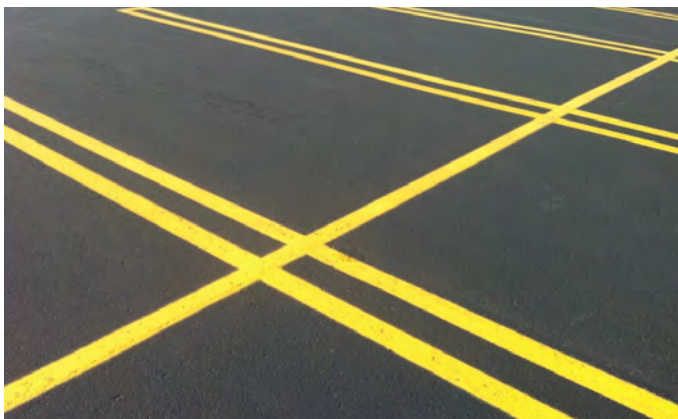

WHAT TO BRING

Surge protector that has an on / off switch
 Alarm clock
 Microwave: 700 watt/.7 cubic feet or less
 Refrigerator: 4 cubic feet or less
 TV that is HD capable
 Stereo, DVD, video games
 Coffeemaker
 Computer and associated equipment
 3M Command strips for hanging posters and pictures
 Laundry detergent, basket, hangers
 Linens for extra long twin bed, towels
 Tension rod/curtain rod for Centennial Hall only
 Carpet or rugs with a non-slip rug pad
 Lamp (no halogens)
 Personal hygiene items
 Flashlight and other tools

WHAT NOT TO BRING

Candles, incense
 Halogen lamps
 Space heaters
 Wireless router
 Any type of extension cord that is not a surge protector with an on/off switch
 Anything with an open heating element, toasters, toaster ovens, hot plates, grills
 Pets, except fish in a 10 gallon aquarium
 Anything that may damage or mark surfaces such as tacks, nails, pins, screws, adhesives, or tape of any kind
 Weapons of any kind
 Alcohol, including full or empty decorative bottles, caps or shot glasses
 Drugs and or drug paraphernalia, including vape pens

FAQ



Where do we go to pick up our key?

Your key will be located in the main lobby of your residence hall. Signs will be posted throughout the residence halls with pertinent information and locations.

Do I need to do anything before I arrive?

Your Admissions paperwork, student account obligations, and financial aid requirements must be complete to avoid a hold on getting moved in. Please complete your online portal check-in a few days before arriving to campus. Offices will be open to assist to complete those requirements during move-in.

Will I get help moving in?

During Freshmen move-in, TLU will have numerous volunteers assisting you. Please label all of your items with your name, building, and room number to ensure they arrive to the correct place. Limited carts will be available on a first come first serve basis.

Which buildings have elevators?

Centennial & Seguin Halls are the only on-campus residence halls with an elevator.

Can I move in early?

We are unable to schedule early move-ins due to rooms being prepped. Severe situations will be addressed by the Campus Living office on a case by case basis.

What do I do if I'm scheduled to move-in with my team / organization? Your coach / organization leader will supply Campus Living with a roster of all students who will move in with their group. Confirm with them for more details.

Will the dining hall be open by the time I arrive?

Dining services will be open at lunch on move-in day and you can begin using your meal plan immediately. Your TLU ID has your meal information pre-loaded onto the card.
