Summer Attendance Is Up!

Summer school at TLU is becoming popular! Last summer, over **300** students took summer classes. More course offerings in the May term, summer A, and summer B have made finding a class that will count toward your degree plan much easier. Also, rates for campus housing have been lowered during the summer terms to as low as \$150 per month. Last summer, enrollment increased by 11%; over the last 5 years, enrollment has increased by 55%.



Developing Scholars Program

Some important things to know about the Developing Scholars program at TLU:

- Number of students on Academic Probation in Fall 2015: **17**, compared to a high of **56** in Fall 2009.
- The Developing Scholars (DS) program, created to aid probation students in returning to good academic standing, provides standing weekly meetings on study strategies, time management, and campus resources.

The Developing Scholars Mentors program, being piloted this semester, allows students who have successfully completed the DS program in the past and are now in good academic standing to act as mentors to students currently in the DS program, as an additional source of support for students.
